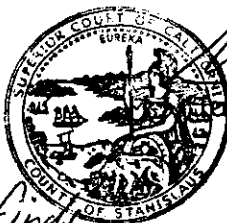

- 20 1) There exists an overriding interest that overcomes the right
- 21 of public access to the record;
- 22 2) The overriding interest supports sealing the record;
- 23 3) A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest
- 24 will be prejudiced if the record is not sealed;
- 25 4) The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored; and
- 26 5) No less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding
- 27 interest.
