FURTHER STIPULATION  
AND ORDER AUTHORIZING  
ADDITIONAL LIMITED  
EXAMINATION OF REMAINS  
AND RELEASE OF REMAINS  
TO NEXT OF KIN

The parties stipulate to the following Order:

This Stipulation and Order has been agreed to by the Contra Costa County Counsel's  
Office.

**Additional Limited Examination of Remains**

1. The Coroner's Division of the Contra Costa County Sheriff-Coroner's Office  
("Coroner") is ordered to permit a defense radiologist expert selected by Mark J. Geragos and/or  
Kirk McAllister to x-ray the remains of the baby Conner Peterson.

2. The x-rays will be taken at the Coroner's facility at 1960 Muir Road, Martinez,  
California, no later than ~~September 5, 2003~~ <sup>August 22 DEK 09</sup>, at a time mutually agreed to by the defense, the  
People, and the Coroner.

3. Only the following persons may be present at the x-ray examination:

- a. Up to four persons for the defense (radiologist, experts, counsel, and support persons).
- b. Up to two persons chosen by the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office.
- c. Up to two Coroner officers (to maintain security and the chain of custody of the remains).
- d. A physician selected by the Coroner.

4. The defense shall be permitted to use the Coroner's x-ray equipment.

5. The defense shall not be responsible for the costs of having the persons identified in subparts (b) through (d) of paragraph three attend the examination. Moreover, the defense shall not be charged for the use of the Coroner's x-ray equipment or facility.

6. Two x-rays will be taken of each position. One x-ray will be furnished to the defense; and one x-ray will be furnished to the People.


**Release of Remains to Next of Kin**

August 22 <sup>SPH</sup>

1. After the taking of the x-rays or ~~September 5~~, 2003, whichever is sooner, the Coroner is authorized to release the remains of Laci Peterson and the baby Conner Peterson to the next of kin.
