

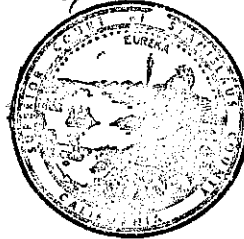
ORDER
